FIRE SAFETY IN THE WORKPLACE

Evacuating the premises safely and effectively is paramount in the event of a fire and the procedure should be familiar to all employees and visitors.

Please see our checklist to help you maintain a safe environment. Fire wardens should be appointed by the Responsible Person, who will establish the number of wardens required.

TIP Try to schedule the tests at the beginning of the week and early on in the day. If any issues present during the test, you may be subject to out-of-hours call out charges.

ENSURE YOU HAVE THE CORRECT NUMBER OF FIRE WARDENS WITHIN YOUR BUSINESS:

A minimum of two fire wardens per floor is required	<input type="checkbox"/>

DAY-TO-DAY FIRE WARDENS NEED TO CHECK THE FOLLOWING:

Fire doors are undamaged and not wedged open. If they are wedged open, remove the wedges and report to the Responsible Person.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Emergency escape routes are clearly signed	<input type="checkbox"/>
Fire exits and escape routes are not blocked, including external routes up to the assembly point	<input type="checkbox"/>
Firefighting equipment, e.g. fire extinguishers and fire blankets are stored correctly, are not missing or damaged	<input type="checkbox"/>
Ensure the doors close in a controlled manner and are free from obstruction	<input type="checkbox"/>
Emergency lighting is working	<input type="checkbox"/>
Rubbish is safely stored away and not overflowing	<input type="checkbox"/>
Sockets are not overloaded and electrical equipment does not have frayed wiring	<input type="checkbox"/>

ADDITIONAL REGULAR CHECKS INCLUDE:

Fire safety training on induction for all new staff	<input type="checkbox"/>
Ensure everyone is familiar with the evacuation procedure	<input type="checkbox"/>
Make sure fire alarms are tested weekly	<input type="checkbox"/>
Ensure the fire alarm can be heard in all areas of the premises	<input type="checkbox"/>
Check smoke detectors have not been covered – especially during building works	<input type="checkbox"/>
Involvement in fire drills at least once a year	<input type="checkbox"/>
