## PASSIVE FIRE PROTECTION

Passive protection products are dormant until the presence of fire is detected, where they automatically react to contain or slow the spread of a fire. They provide essential services in a fire situation, preventing fire and smoke from spreading, restricting damage to the building and allowing occupants to escape safely.

## FIRE DOORS

Fire doors are probably the most well-known form of passive protection. They prevent the spread of smoke and fire, separate different fire hazards and ensure that evacuation routes are always protected. Our service technicians can install, inspect and maintain fire doors to the highest standard, customised to your requirements. With our fire doors, you can have peace of mind that in the event of a fire your staff and customers will be able to escape safely, the fire will be contained and the damage to your building will be limited.

## OTHER PRODUCTS

Passive protection products usually remain dormant, reacting in the case of a fire. We can install a number of products with an intumescent coating that swells up when heated, keeping the product itself undamaged. These include fire stopping batts, seals, collars and wraps for PVC pipes and downlighter covers/hoods.

Each of our passive protection products can be installed either in an existing building or included as part of a new build. They operate automatically, so you can be sure of your building's safety without having to worry about human error.

## **MAINTENANCE**

Churches Fire & Security provides a servicing programme to ensure that all products are functioning correctly. This involves inspections at least once a year by a trained technician, to check for any damage, usually as part of the fire risk assessment.

Where any building works or developments may have taken place, it is recommended that all passive protection is examined to ensure no damage has occurred. This is particularly important around wall penetrations where cables or pipes have been installed or between compartments following the installation of new doors or windows.
